By this petition, anticipatory bail is sought by the petitioner, upon FIR No. 93 dated 05.10.2016 having been registered against her and her co-accused, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC.

At the time when notice was issued on 16.11.2016, the petitioner had been ordered to be released on ad interim bail upon joining investigation.
