FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner Amit @ Sumit in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that on 11.09.2017 from the possession of petitioner one illegal country made .315 bore pistol was recovered without any licence and authorization.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 11.09.2017 and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

Learned State counsel has stoutly opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground that illegal weapon has been recovered from the petitioner.

Keeping in view the contentions of the two sides and

having regard to the period of incarceration and the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
