By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 15.04.2015, registered under Section 306 of IPC, at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

On 23.11.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Contends that the petitioner has been involved in the present case, on the basis of suicide note of the father of the complainant. The dead body has not yet been recovered.

Notice of motion for 17.01.2017.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice. A complete copy of the paper book has been handed over to learned State counsel, in the Court.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by

the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:

- 1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement,threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3.That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court. ”*

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 23.11.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.11.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
