By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' in FIR no.696 dated 16.11.2015 registered against him for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 406/420 IPC.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner has tried to argue the case on merits, however, no comment in that regard is being made as learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner was declared to be a proclaimed offender on 26.08.2016 and thereafter arrested on 14.09.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on the other hand submits that actually the petitioner surrendered.

He further submits that the trial is still to begin, with even

charges not framed as yet and 13 witnesses to be examined.

Without a doubt the petitioner has been in custody for the past five months approximately; however, keeping in view his past conduct, I do not consider it appropriate to grant bail to him, at this stage.

Dismissed.
