The present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.91 dated 12.07.2013 registered at Police Station Phase XI, District SAS Nagar, Mohali for offence punishable under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') on the basis of settlement/compromise dated 01.04.2015.

Perusal of the record would reveal that complainant/respondent No.2 did not appear in the Court despite service through her father. A report has been received from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali dated 04.02.2016 that the complainant did not appear before the Court for recording her statement. It appears that either there is no compromise between the parties or the complainant does not agree with the compromise. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner to say something in the matter.

That being so, the petition is ordered to be dismissed.
