Petitioner-Lalit @ Ali has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.212 dated 26.03.2017, registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad, under Sections 452, 323, 307, 506 and 503 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (however charges have been framed under Sections 307, 458, 459 and 323 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR. As per the prosecution version, he fired from the pistol, but it did not hit anybody. Simple injuries with the '*Butt*' of the pistol have been attributed to the petitioner.

The petitioner has been in custody since 26.03.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
