Present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.501 dated 01.10.2017 under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner was falsely implicated under the Arms Act in another case bearing FIR No.545 dated 09.11.2004, whereas he had been tried and acquitted. More so, nothing was recovered from the present petitioner. In the present case, as per FIR, he fled away from the spot.

Learned State counsel contended that the petitioner was named in the FIR and he fled away from the spot after leaving 14 kgs kachra doda post and he is required for custodial interrogation and there is no occasion for granting bail to him, and the present petition be dismissed.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel

for the parties and the fact that the petitioner was named in the FIR and fled

away from the spot and he was known to the Investigating Officer, no ground for enlarging the petitioner on anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
