The present petition has been filed under Section 439 the Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in case FIR No.39 dated 20.07.2016, registered under Sections 15, 18 and 22 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Gurdaspur.

ASI Malkit Singh, who is present in the Court, states that 37 strips were counted and packed in the box in the presence of the learned Magistrate. The case property was deposited in the Malkhana after it was sealed by the learned Magistrate. However, when the case property with seal intact was opened in this Court, only 35 strips as against 37 were found in the box.

In the circumstances, without commenting further on the above development, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur is directed to look into the matter and send report in this regard within four weeks from today to the Registrar General of this Court.
