The petitioner has filed the present revision under Section 401 Cr.P.C. against the order dated 5/7.6.2003 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Faridabad whereby respondent No.2-Smt. Asharfi stood acquitted of the charges against her whereas respondent No.1-Zile Singh was convicted and sentenced for the offences under Sections 302 and 201 IPC. In the revision, the petitioner has prayed for setting aside the acquittal of respondent No.2-Smt. Asharfi and for enhancement of sentence of imprisonment and fine of respondent No.1-Zile Singh.

Against his conviction and sentence, Zile Singh had filed Criminal Appeal D-545-DB of 2003 which has been disposed of by an order of even date as having abated on account of his death.

Learned State counsel, after obtaining instructions from ASI Mohd. Harun, Police Station Sadar, Palwal has informed the Court that respondent No.2-Smt. Asharfi has also passed away during the pendency of the revision.

Once convict-Zile Singh and accused-Smt.Asharfi, who were the contesting respondents in the revision, have passed away, the present revision abates and is disposed of accordingly.
