Heard.

The challan against petitioner under Sections 420/467/468/469/471 IPC has been presented before the learned Illaqa Magistrate and the trial is going on. The petitioner is in custody since 23.7.2017. The petitioner has produced affidavit of Daljeet Singh (complainant), stating that he has compromised with the victim.

The learned counsel for complainant Daljeet Singh is also present in Court today and he has affirmed the compromise.

Therefore, considering that trial will take time and offence is triable by lower Court, further detention of petitioner is considered unnecessary. Therefore, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of rupees 50000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
