This order will dispose of the aforesaid three petitions as these are inter-linked.

Heard.

The relief sought by the petitioner in this petition is that the first appellate court be given direction to decide the application filed by the petitioners seeking permission to deposit the cheque amount as per the observations of the Apex Court in the case of **Damodar S. Prabhu v. Sayed Babalal H.** 2010 (2) RCR (Criminal) 851.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that only purpose of the petitioner is to delay the proceedings and he is not serious in furnishing the drafts before the Court or to settle the dispute.

All the three petitions are disposed of with direction to the first appellate court to hear the parties on the application and dispose of the same at the earliest prior to deciding the appeal on merits.
