Present petitioner Joginder Singh is a witness in a murder case.

It is claimed that Arms licence has been granted to the petitioner. The short prayer made was that whenever petitioner Joginder Singh wants to appear in the Court as witness, he shall be granted adequate protection. The State has not opposed the grant of protection which has been extended to the witness in a murder case pertaining to FIR No.38 dated 15.5.2013 under Sections 302/148/149/120-B IPC and Section 25/54 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Tapa, District Barnala.

As such, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to provide adequate security to petitioner Joginder Singh when he has to appear as a witness in a murder

case pertaining to FIR No.38 dated 15.5.2013 under Sections 302/148/149/120-B IPC and Section 25/54 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Tapa, District Barnala and to ensure that he is not influenced or harmed by the opposite party.
