[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. J.S. Walia, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioner prays for quashing of the impugned order dated 16.10.2017 passed by the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in Sessions Case No.194 of his Court.

[4]. The petitioner was originally on bail in the concerned criminal proceedings arising out of FIR No.293 dated 22.12.2014 of Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana. He, however, absented from the proceedings in the Trial Court on the relevant date without intimation, on account of which non-bailable warrants of arrest were ordered to be issued against him. His explanation in this regard is that his absence was not deliberate or intentional but there was miscommunication in the date of

appearance fixed in the Trial Court which he understood to be 18.10.2017.

[5]. It further transpires that the next date fixed in the Ld. Court below is tomorrow itself i.e. 03.11.2017.

[6]. In the circumstances, considering the grounds made out in the petition, the prayer of the petitioner is allowed. Operation of the impugned order is stayed till tomorrow with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court again and apply for fresh bail.
