This petition has been filed against the order dated 01.10.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar, dismissing the revision filed by petitioner-wife against the order dated 20.12.2013 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Jagadhri, whereby application filed by her under Section 125 Cr. P.C., has been dismissed.

While dismissing application under Section 125 Cr.P.C., it has been observed that the petitioner-wife had inherited landed property left by her deceased sons. Apart from 33 Kanals of land, she is having approximately Rs.34,00,000/- in cash and one house. It has been further observed from the aforesaid amount of Rs.34,00,000/-, she can get interest of about Rs.12,000/- to Rs.15,000/- per month, which is sufficient to maintain her.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner has sold 33 Kanals of land for Rs.53,62,500/- and thereafter, she has purchased one house in Jagadhri for a sum of Rs.19,20,000/-. Thus, she is having enough funds to maintain

herself.

After going through the impugned orders, no illegality, much less perversity, has been found therein warranting interference by this Court.

Dismissed.
