This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in
FIR No.145 dated 27.10.2016 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B
IPC at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

On 28.11.2016, this Court passed the following
order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is not a
beneficiary and he is only an attesting witness to the
agreement to sell.

Notice of motion for 23.01.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by
the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim
bail subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) That he shall make himself available for interrogation
by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) That he shall not directly or indirectly make any
inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted

with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

(iii) That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that in pursuance of the order dated 28.11.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 28.11.2016 is made absolute, subject to furnishing of fresh bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
