Vakalatnama filed on behalf of the complainant is taken on record.

Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.124 dated 02.09.2017 registered under Sections 323, 325, 326, 452, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he caused three *danda* blows to injured Devender Singh, which have been declared 'simple in nature'.

Learned counsel inter-alia contends that the petitioner is in custody since 22.09.2017. The conclusion of the trial shall take sufficient long time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any further in jail.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
