The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 53 dated 29.09.2017, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners are that they had wrongly got the land measuring 13.5 kanals, which allegedly belongs to the complainant mutated in their favour on 07.02.2013. He further contends that the mutation was cancelled by the Revenue Officer on 08.03.2013 and the possession remained with the complainant. The FIR has been registered after four years.

This Court vide order dated 02.11.2017, had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the

conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Pawan Kumar states that in pursuance to the order dated 02.11.2017 the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, the petitioners having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 02.11.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
