Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.220 dated 24.09.2016 under Sections 307, 452 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.7 (Vardhman), Distirct Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. More so, he is in custody since 25.09.2016 and the allegations against the petitioner that he had caused injuries with knife and during the trial main witnesses i.e. complainant, injured and eyewitness have been examined and decision of the case still to take some more time. So he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that remaining prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined and the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature, therefore he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 25.09.2016; decision of the case still to take some more time. More so, material witnesses of the case have already been examined and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, Ludhiana.

The petition stands allowed.
