Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.01 dated 03.02.2017, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13(1) (D) read with Section 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Jalandhar. This Court had made an order dated 02.11.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
