In FIR No.52 dated 27.03.2016, under Sections 447, 448, 380 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Chherreta, District Amritsar, the petitioners seek quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned JMIC, Amritsar stating that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is genuine.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR

No.52 dated 27.03.2016, under Sections 447, 448, 380 of IPC, registered at Police Station Chherreta, District Amritsar alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
