Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.601 dated 20.09.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 302 IPC read with Section 3(2)(V) of the SC/ST Act added lateron), at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

It is not disputed by learned counsel for the respondent-State that the material witnesses, during the trial, have turned hostile.
