Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was initially not named in the FIR but subsequently, in the investigation, he was named as one of the many persons who attacked the house of the Director General of Police and even then the only role attributed to him is with regard to throwing stones at the house. Thus it is contended that no offence under Section 307 IPC is made out against the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the actual merits of the contention that no offence under Section 307 IPC is made out, however, at this stage, since the petitioner is stated to be in custody since June 2016 and the role attributed to him is of being one amongst many throwing stones only, he is ordered to be released on bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, subject to his continuing to appear before the trial Court as and when summoned and complying with all other conditions as would be laid down by that Court.
