The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, has been filed seeking anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.104 dated 20.05.2017, registered under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar Rural.

The trial Court has granted the interim bail to the petitioner till receiving the report of FSL/Chemical Examiner, vide order dated 01.07.2017. Later on, when the report of chemical Examiner was received, it was found that recovery falls in the commercial quantity and the petitioner was absent from the Court proceeding instead of surrendering before the Court.

No ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
