Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.4 dated 04.01.2014 registered under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

FIR came to be registered against the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.2. Compromise was executed between the parties and a copy thereof, was supplied to the Investigating Officer.

Vide order dated 05.12.2016, respondent No.2/complainant was given liberty to approach the Investigating Officer for making supplementary statement. In the event of making

supplementary statement by the complainant, the Investigating Officer was obligated to record the same as per mandate of Section 163(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI, Baldev Singh admitted that the complainant has already approached the Investigating Officer and his supplementary statement has been recorded in the context of compromise and a copy of which has already been supplied to the Investigating Officer.

The factum of compromise has been found as a matter of fact. All the petitioners/accused in the FIR have also appeared before the Investigating Officer and have testified regarding genuineness of the compromise in question. Investigating Officer, ASI, Baldev Singh who is present in the Court also admitted that both the parties have amicably resolved their differences.

Resultantly, FIR No.4 dated 04.01.2014 registered under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby ordered to be quashed..

Petition stands disposed of.
