Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.41 dated 18.04.2017 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 427 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Lohian and the cross case DDR No.26 dated 18.04.2017 registered in aforesaid F.I.R. No.41, on the basis of compromise dated 18.09.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 02.11.2017 (in CRM-M-41375-2017) and 07.11.2017 (in CRM-M-41698-2017) passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar on 22.11.2017 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received (in CRM-M-41375-2017) vide letter No.7665 dated 28.11.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar, the compromise between the parties is voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.41 and cross case DDR No.26, are quashed qua the petitioners, subject to depositing costs of ₹5,000/- each case by the petitioners with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week.

The Registry is directed to report whether the cost is deposited by the petitioner or not.
