The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail in case FIR No.57 dated 27.06.2017 registered under Sections 354-B, 456 and 506 IPC at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The alleged incident has taken place on 26.06.2017 whereas, the FIR was registered after a gap of one day on 27.06.2017. The petitioner is in custody since 27.06.2017.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application. It is submitted that the petitioner has committed the offence in question when he was on parole in some other case. The petitioner is involved in four more FIRs i.e. FIR No.91/06 under

Section 302 IPC, FIR No.63/12 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, FIR No.37/11 registered under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, FIR No.25/12 registered under Section 382 IPC registered at Police Station Boha. He is a convict in an NDPS Act case.

Heard.

There are specific allegations against the petitioner, who admittedly was on parole. Considering the antecedents and the fact that the petitioner has misused the concession of parole, this Court feels that no case for grant of bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
