The petitioner has filed the aforesaid petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.229 dated 04.06.2017 registered under Sections 147, , 148, 294, 323, 325, 326, 341 & 506 IPC at Police Station Barwala, District Hisar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

From the perusal of the record I find that first of all, the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class and the petitioners have been in custody for more than four months. Moreover, compromise has taken place between the parties and it is a case of version and cross-version.

Now, the petitioners are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

In that view of the matter, without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-41383 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
