Notice of motion was issued on 05.02.2016 on *prima facie* existence of compromise between the parties. Thereafter, the case was adjourned on different occasions at the instance of the petitioner for seeking instructions with regard to refund of money to the complainant as well as for bringing out the modelities of likely settlement between the parties. On 10.01.2017, learned counsel for the petitioner sought last opportunity to resolve the matter in the light of alleged initial compromise between the parties vide which petitioner had agreed to return the amount in question. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner informed the Court that despite his repeated efforts, whereabouts of the petitioner could not be known.

In view of aforesaid, this Court finds no way out except to dismiss the petition.
