This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.699, dated 06.10.2016, under Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad, Haryana.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

The instant FIR has been registered on account of non-appearance of the petitioner in proceedings initiated vide Criminal Complaint No.2070, dated 20.12.2014, under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act filed by Mittal Pigments Pvt. Ltd.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner had thereafter associated with the trial proceedings and in any case, the complainant has since withdrawn the complaint in question.

Under such circumstances, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction that no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner, in pursuance to the registration of FIR No.699, dated 06.10.2016, under

Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad.
