The petitioners have questioned the validity of their termination order dated 9.10.2007. Order of termination reads as under:

“No.Mal./Estt.-2007/1388

Dated 9.10.2007

From

Civil Surgeon, Jind

To

Satpal s/o Dalel

Subject: Termination of services.

On the subject cited above.

Your services are not needed by the department now. So, your services are terminated from 9.10.2007 after noon.”

Perusal of the order of termination, it is crystal clear that it is not a speaking order. No reason has been assigned as to why the petitioners are not required in the department. The petitioners are working since 1983-84. From time to time, their appointments have been renewed.

Accordingly, order of termination dated 9.10.2007 is set aside.

Concerned respondents are hereby directed to extend the service benefit including monetary benefits within a period of two months from today. If

the concerned respondent feel that petitioners' services are not required, issue notice to the petitioners and after receipt of petitioners' explanation, the same may be considered in accordance with law by passing a speaking order. The above exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from today.

Petition stands allowed.
