Learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits that the petitioner would feel contended in case his representations (Annexures P3 and P4) are decided by respondent No.4. Petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty from being invaded by the private respondents and also to initiate lawful proceedings against them.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the case, respondent No.4 can be directed to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner. Respondent No.4 would be at liberty to devise his own ways and means to ascertain truth behind the allegations. In case, respondent No.4 finds some truth in the allegations of the petitioner, then necessary action be taken in furtherance of providing adequate protection to the petitioner. However, respondent No.4 would not be swayed away by any observation made by this Court. At this stage, he would independently enquire into the matter without being influenced by any observation.
