INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Kiran has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.61 dated 15.06.2015, registered at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala, under Section 420 IPC and Sections 467 and 468 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition. However, none has appeared on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 3 despite service.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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In pursuance of the interim order dated 28.11.2016, the present petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is now not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

At the time of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that parties have already effected compromise and a copy of compromise deed has been placed on record as Annexure P-2. Furthermore, perusal of the FIR shows that no specific allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner. The allegations are general in nature and have been levelled in respect of inducement by Ravinder.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 28.11.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
