Learned counsel for the petitioners reiterate what they had
stated earlier, with learned counsel for the State also reiterating what he had
submitted, i.e. that that there was faint recognition of both the petitioners in

the CCTV footage.

It is seen that as per the custody certificate filed in Court today, petitioner Gagan Behki @ Gaggi has been in custody for 6 months and 13 days, with the charge also not framed as yet and as per the custody certificate, there is no other criminal case registered against him.

As regards petitioner Balwinder pal @ Balli, learned State counsel on instructions submits that there is also no other criminal case registered against him and he is in custody for a like period.

Consequently, the petitions are allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, upon their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds.
