Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.352 dated 16.06.2016 registered under Section 307 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act (challan filed under Sections 302, 201 and 120-B IPC), at Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurugram.

According to the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith his co-accused, after giving beatings to the deceased son of the complainant, namely, Billu, took him to the market of Sector-21, Gurugram and caused fire arm injury to him, on account of which he, ultimately, succumbed to his injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contended that the complainant as PW1 before the trial Court has turned hostile. The petitioner

is in custody since 25.06.2016. Conclusion of trial shall take sufficient long

time, thus, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in jail.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
