Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, Police Station Kathunangal, District Amritsar submits that petitioner No.1 Ganga Singh and petitioner No.2 Hardial Singh have since been found innocent during investigations and are no more accused in this case and petitioner No.3 Sukhwinder Singh in compliance of orders dated 22.12.2016 has since joined the investigation and that nothing is to be recovered from him and has not opposed the grant of bail to petitioner No.3/Sukhwinder Singh.

Faced with this situation learned counsel for the petitioner has made statement withdrawing the present petition qua petitioner No.1 Ganga Singh and petitioner No.2 Hardial Singh.

Allowed to do so. In the light of this stand of State *Ad interim* orders dated 22.12.2016 passed by this Court are made absolute on the same terms and conditions qua petitioner No.3 Sukhwinder Singh.

The petition stands disposed off.
