Petitioner-Gursewak Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.219 dated 19.10.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, under Sections 307, 324, 341 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is named in the FIR and is stated to be armed with rifle. He fired two shots. The complainant saved himself from one and other hit on his scooter. Though no injury has been caused by the petitioner but he is one of the main accused.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts

that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and weapon is still to be recovered from him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
