The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.105 dated 15.08.2017 under Sections 307/341/323/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he has caused an injury on the left side of chest of father of the complainant with the reverse side of the Spade. He further contends that as per first MLR, the injury was held to be only greivous in nature as only multiple bruises were found thereon. However, police obtained a second medical opinion wherein the doctor opined that if timely medical attention had not been given, the injury could have been dangerous to life. He further contends that petitioner is in custody for over two and a half months since his arrest on 17.08.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gursewak Singh, states that investigation has been completed and challan is likely to be filed within next ten days.

Heard.

In view of submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view that investigation has been completed, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the petition is allowed and petitioner Som Nath @ Bhola shall be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate.
