The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.73 dated 17.08.2017 under Sections 356/379-B IPC registered at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that allegations against the petitioners are that they had snatched ear-rings of the complainant. He further contends that although the incident is stated to have taken place on 10.08.2017 at 3:00 PM but the matter was reported to the police after seven days on 17.08.2017. He also contends that petitioners are in custody for over two and a half months since their arrest on 17.08.2017. The petitioners are not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Lal Chand, states that investigation has been completed and challan is likely to be filed shortly.

Heard.

In view of submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, especially when FIR has been lodged after one week and keeping in view that investigation has been completed, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the petition is allowed and both the petitioners namely Vijay and Jeeta shall be released on regular bail on their furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate.
