INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners-Mehar Singh, Raj Kumar, Subhash Chander, Gurmeet Singh and Gurcharan Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 praying for blanket bail to them that in a case on the basis of any complaint received by the official respondents from the private respondents, the petitioners be given one week prior notice before their arrest.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioners are asking for blanket bail which is not permissible as per law. It is not the case of the petitioners that any specific complaint has been filed before the police authorities and the petitioners are not asking for one week prior notice in

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that specific complaint. They are asking that if any complaint is received from the private respondents, then they may be given one week prior notice, which amounts to blanket bail and the same cannot be granted.

In view of the above, I do not find any merit in this petition and the same is dismissed.
