Quashing of FIR No. 334 dated 07.08.2015 under Sections 498-A/406/506/354/377 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad, District Faridabad, is being sought on the basis of compromise deed.

The marriage of respondent No.2/complainant was solemnized with petitioner No.3-Raunak Kapoor as per Hindu rights. Out of the said wedlock, one son namely Tavish Kapoor was born on 16.03.2014. The allegations made in the FIR are that she has faced harassment at the hands of family members of the petitioners. The parties have agreed to file a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage by way of mutual consent.

In compliance of the order dated 08.12.2015/21.10.2016, report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, has been received in this regard. As per the report, statement of the complainant/respondent No.2 and the petitioners have been recorded. Complainant has stated that the matter has been compromised between the parties with the intervention of respectable. She has received a sum of ₹5,00,000/- and does not want to proceed with the case further. The compromise arrived at between the parties is without any pressure, threat or undue influence.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of "**Dr.Arvind Barsaul etc v. State of Madhya Pradesh and another**" 2008 (2) RCR (Criminal) 910, no useful purpose would be served by prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.334 dated 07.08.2015 under Sections 498-A/406/506/354/377 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad, District Faridabad, is hereby quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners only.

The petition stands disposed of.
