Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. In response to the petition, Gurmail Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East), Amritsar has filed reply by way of affidavit. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the police took lot of time for collecting the samples and sending them to the FSL. Learned Counsel for the State states that needful has been done and reminders have been sent to the FSL for report.
