Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of necessary direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made a representation dated 31.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) to the respondent No.3 i.e. Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Division, District Ferozepur, and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) and to act in accordance with law. It is made clear that in case no such representation has been submitted by the petitioner, it shall not be obligatory for respondent No.3 to take note of this order.
