The petitioner is seeking interim bail for attending the marriage of his son which is fixed for 12.11.2017.

The petitioner is facing trial in FIR No.39 dated 11.04.2017 under Section 302/34 IPC registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that while he was armed with a stick, he along with seven other persons, some of whom were armed with datar and kappa, had caused injuries to the deceased. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 26.04.2017. He further contends that ceremonies in connection of the marriage of son of the petitioner are to be performed on 11th and 12th November, 2017 and he may be granted interim bail for a period of one week. He has also drawn my attention to invitation card, copy of which have been annexed as Annexure P-3 (colly) with the petition, wherein it is

mentioned that ceremonies in connection with marriage of son of the petitioner are to be performed on 11th and 12th November, 2017 at village Dadupura, District Amritsar. A copy of report of the Panchayat has also been annexed as Annexure P-4 which mentions that Sarpanch and other members of the Panchayat have given a report in favour of release of the petitioner on interim bail.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Balwinder Singh, states that ceremonies in connection of marriage of the son of petitioner are indeed to be performed on 11th and 12th November, 2017.

Heard.

The marriage ceremonies of the son of petitioner are to be performed on 11th and 12th November, 2017 and his presence would be required for conducting the ceremonies.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner Anoop Singh is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing adequate bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate. He shall be released on interim bail at 11:00 AM on 10.11.2017 and shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur by 4:00 PM on 15.11.2017.
