Petitioner-Ramesh Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.203 dated 18.05.2016, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak, under Sections 302, 201, 397, 379-B, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that in the present case, there is no allegation of involvement of the present petitioner in the murder as well

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as in snatching. The only allegation against him is that Hiva Dampher in question was sold by him in Meerut.

The petitioner has been in custody since 25.11.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
