The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.91 dated 23.12.2014, under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 IPC, PS Tibber, District Gurdaspur on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 30.11.2016, report of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned FIR, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
