Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.255 dated 03.12.2015 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh.

Learned State counsel states that as against the total 10 witnesses cited by the prosecution, as many as 3 witnesses have been examined whereas 3 witnesses have been given up and only 4 witnesses are required to be examined who are otherwise officials. The case is now fixed for 04.01.2018 for remaining evidence.

In view of advance stage of trial, no case for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and to conclude the same preferably within a period of 4 months.
