LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 145 dated 17.12.2016 registered under Sections 498A/406 IPC at Police Station City Jalalabad (W), District Fazilka.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the parties that during the pendency of this petition, the matter has been amicably settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Settlement/agreement dated 27.04.2017 is attached with this file. It is informed that the petitioner and respondent No. 2 are now living together in their matrimonial home alongwith their minor daughter.

In view of the settlement between the parties, it is submitted that respondent No. 2 does not have any objection to this petition being allowed subject to strict adherence of the terms and conditions of the settlement by the petitioner. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation. There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond, if released on bail. Factum of the complainant now living with the petitioner is affirmed.

Keeping in view the facts as mentioned above specifically the settlement arrived at between the parties, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 13.02.2017 is made absolute.

Liberty is afforded to respondent No. 2 to move an appropriate application, in case, the petitioner does not adhere to the terms and conditions of the settlement.
