Petitioner-Pardeep Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.114 dated 15.12.2016, registered at Police Station Naggal, District Ambala, under Sections 406, 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, an agreement was executed between the complainant and M/s Shree Krishna Agro Foods whose proprietor is Pardeep Kumar, for custom milling of paddy during the year 2013-14. It is mentioned in the FIR that 7180.99 MTs of paddy were supplied by the complainant to the said rice mill. However, neither the complete quantity of rice was delivered nor the amount was paid. As per the FCI rates, the value of 2138.92 MTs of rice comes out to be

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₹5,31,40,363/-.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, in view of nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
