The deceased-Rekha had committed suicide in the house of her parents because of her husband who has solemnized the second marriage with some other girl at Delhi, without giving divorce to Rekha (since deceased). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no case for abetment of suicide is made out against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, has informed the Court that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
