RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that out of total amount of Rs.6 lacs, an amount of Rs.66,500/- was paid to the travel agent namely Gurdeep Singh Arora. An amount of Rs.47,000/- was paid towards ticket. An amount of Rs.3,67,000/- was paid as college fee in Inter Napa college and an additional amount of Rs.22,000/- was utilized towards miscellaneous charges. In this way, total amount of Rs.5,02,500/- was utilized. The very allegation that an amount of Rs.3500 Euro was to be paid by the petitioner himself towards fee of the college would remain on arguable note in view of balance amount value with the petitioner after deducting his service charges.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI, Jagtar Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of above, orders dated 30.11.2016 and 15.02.2017 are made absolute.
